



Start with one big strip of paper.

Decide what order you'd like your hearts to appear and pile them up in reverse order.

Starting about three-fifths of the way down the strip, make two dobs of glue and stick on just the two bumps of the top of the first heart.

Add two dobs of glue just above the top of that heart and attach the next heart in the same way.

Repeat until all 15 hearts are stuck on – you should be able to ruffle up all the points of them.

Put a line of glue along the top of the second strip and stick it to the back of the first one.

Trim the bottom corners off both strips to make a V-shape.

Now cut out and stick on the words starting with "Love" on the topmost heart and ending with "never fails" on the bottom one.

Take the smallest strip — this will form a band round the back strip. Place it underneath both strips at right-angles — the ends will stick out. Fold them over the front and then open them out again. Put glue on these ends, now lift up the bottom-most heart and glue the ends behind it.

Stick the scripture reference on the back.

Now you can shimmy the words by sliding the back strip down and up.
